Then the education part should be in tabular form, if you have a good percentage then only show it and always write recent qualifications first. Then write your those achievements

which will help you in getting a job then soft and technical skill, never lie in your resume then you can write hobbies if you want and at last your details" these were the points which were deeply discussed and were beneficial for the students it was a fruitful session as many students learn about how they can build the resume.
