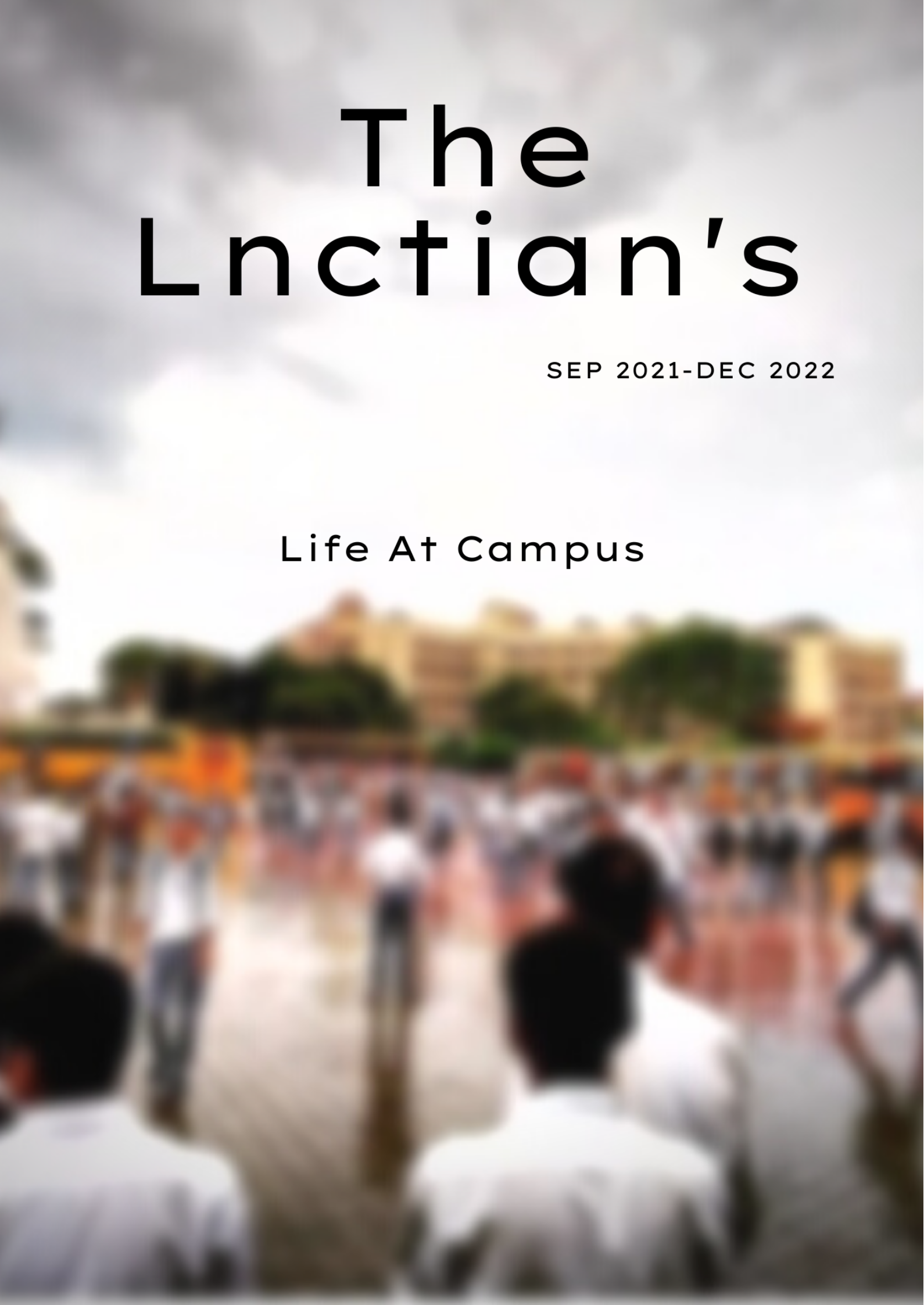

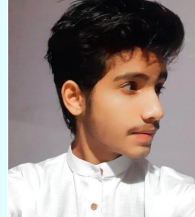

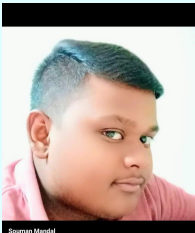

“Interview Strategies”

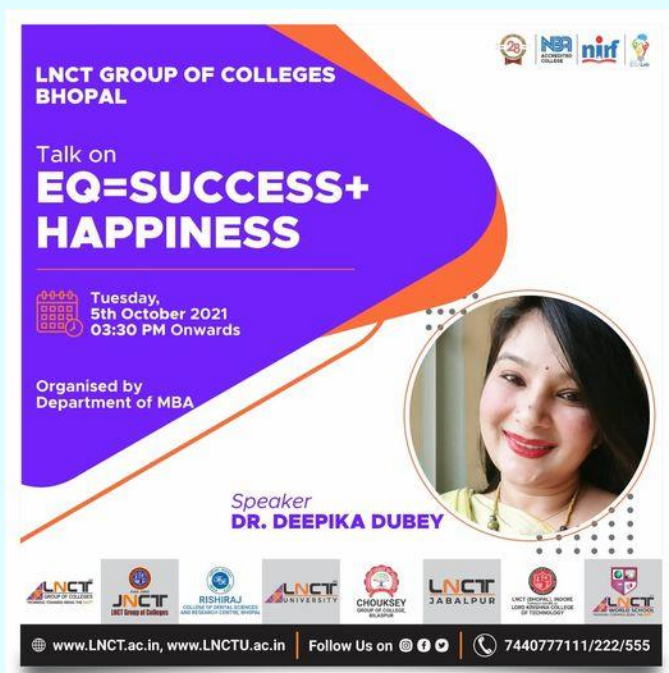
