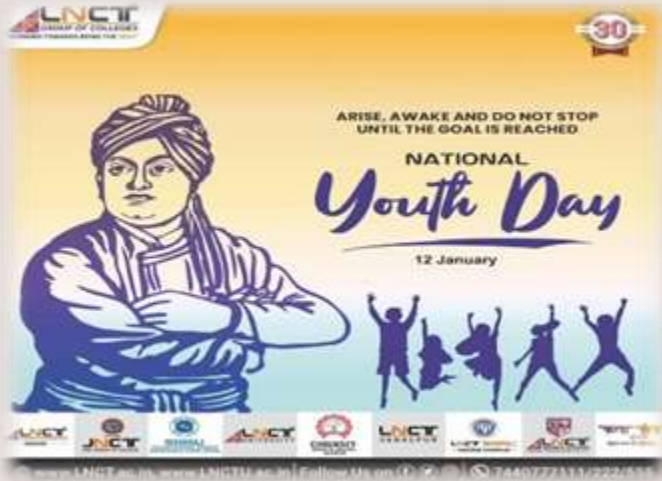
Another Version:

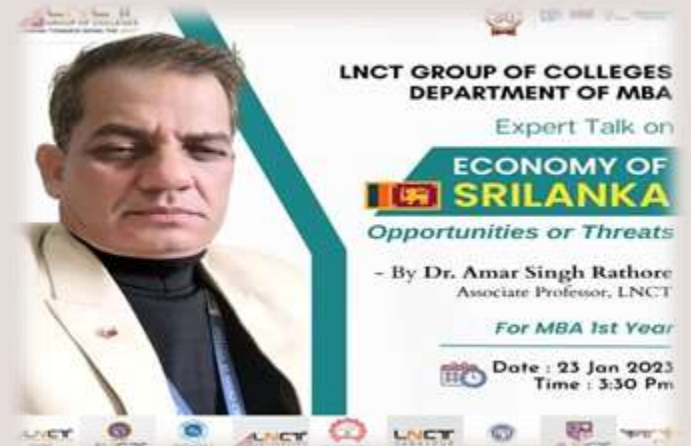
Arrow Model-18th January

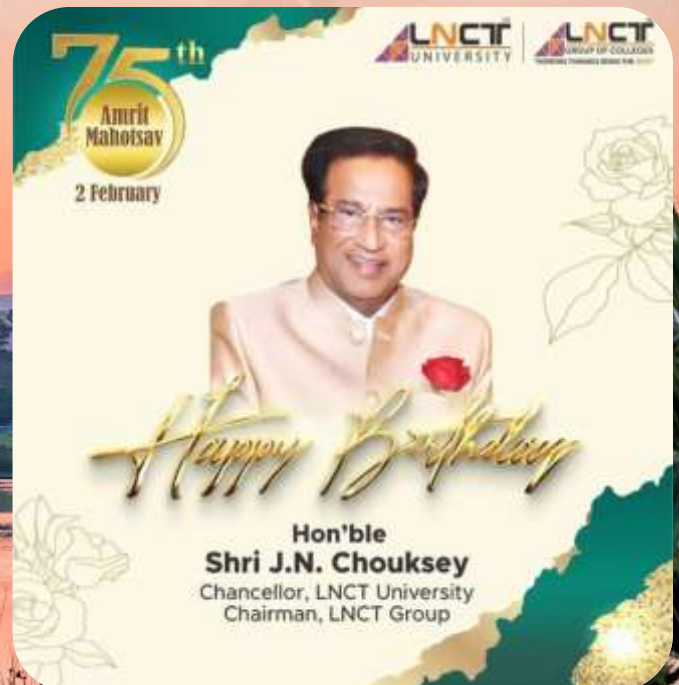
Republic Day celebration- 26 January
