Industrial Visit To Sanchi Dugdh Sangh : Where Systems Build Trust

Sanchi is a trusted part of daily life in Madhya Pradesh, widely used across households.

An industrial visit to Bhopal Sahakari Dugdh Sangh Maryadit, Habibganj on 17th April, 2026. Gave LNCT MBA students a clear understanding of its operations. Milk is procured from village societies after testing at source and transported in insulated tankers, which are cleaned after each use to maintain hygiene.

At the plant, milk is pasteurized, cooled and segregated into variants like Gold, Shakti and Taaza. Products such as curd, paneer and buttermilk are also processed under controlled conditions. Hygiene is strictly maintained across all units, including pipelines, equipment and storage systems.



What stood out most was the strong human supervision at every stage, working alongside machinery to ensure smooth and consistent operations.

The visit was coordinated by Mr. Som Shekhar Sir and Mr. Satish Mewada Sir, helping students understand the process in a structured manner.

Overall, the visit reflected how structured processes, hygiene and human involvement together ensure quality and reliability in everyday consumption.

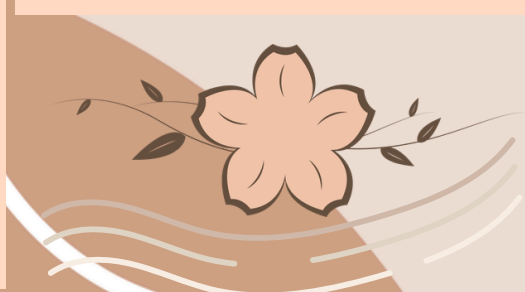

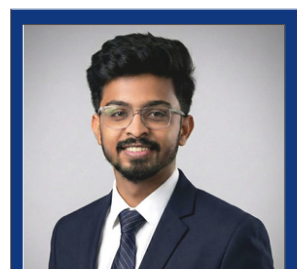

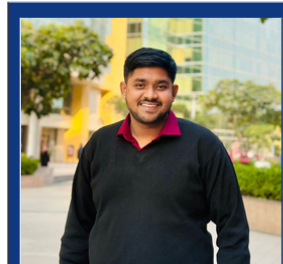
